TNYH Short Course Scoring

Please note that all points awarded represent penalty points, so the lowest individual scores for dressage, jumping or the combined places higher in the ribbons.

The Optimum course time to complete the jumping division may be faster by 20 seconds and NOT incur penalties, however if the rider finishes over the optimum time, penalty points will be incurred with 0.4 penalty point for every second slower than the optimum time and conversely for every second faster than the 20 second window will incur 0.8 penalty point per second.

For a rail down in stadium 5 penalty points will be incurred.

For a refusal in stadium 10 penalty points will be incurred.

For Cross Country first refusal 20 penalty points, second refusal same fence 40 penalty points. For third refusal at the same fence, the rider will be eliminated.

If a rider has a total of five refusals over the entire cross country course, on the fifth refusal the rider will be eliminated.

*As this is a schooling show a rider who is eliminated due to three refusals at the same fence, the rider will have the option to complete the course to school as Haute Concors, but will no longer be scored, if two successive refusals occur the rider will be asked to leave the course.

We strongly suggest if you have difficulty and are eliminated but allowed to continue to school that you school the lower height course.

Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place for placing in dressage, jumping and combined. Ribbons will be awarded at the conclusion of each division. Please attend the clubhouse at the conclusion of the jumping phase for your division for ribbon presentations.

Dressage test scores will be handed out to competitors upon return of your bib number.
